Submission Guidelines

Eligibility

The exhibit is open to all of Missouri's female residents, 18 years of age and older. Both professional and student work will be selected for the exhibit.

Submission Procedure and Guidelines

1. Fill out Entry Form and Artist Information for each submission.
 - No more than three pieces may be submitted per artist. No more than one piece per artist will be selected for the exhibit.
 - All work must have been completed within the last two years.
 - Artwork previously submitted or exhibited in the Craft Studio Gallery will not be considered.
2. Mail or hand-deliver the following FOUR ITEMS to the Craft Studio:
 - Entry Form and Artist Information** (Please print e-mail address clearly; notifications will be sent via e-mail.)
 - CD with artwork** (note: no physical artwork or slides will be accepted)
 - No more than two images of each piece will be accepted.
 - Digital images must be in .jpg or .pdf format ONLY, with a resolution of at least 300 pixels/inch and no larger than 8x10 in.
 - Please label your files in the following format:
YourInitials-title.jpeg/pdf
 - Contact us if you need help photographing artwork or creating a CD; we will do so for \$5.
 - CDs will not be returned.
 - Artist Statement** (a brief statement about each piece; 2 – 4 sentences)
 - Entry Fee.** *This fee is non-refundable.* Cash, check, and Student Charge (MU students only) accepted. Make checks payable to MSA/ GPC Craft Studio.
 - MU STUDENTS: one piece for \$15; two or three for \$30.
 - PUBLIC/COMMUNITY: one piece for \$20; two or three for \$40.

Notification

- *Everyone* who submitted artwork will be notified February 22 - 23 via e-mail. If e-mail is unavailable a letter will be sent.
- Artists whose work has been selected will receive an exhibit agreement, which will include more specific information about gallery policies.
- Selected artwork and gallery agreement (**two signed copies**) must be delivered to the Craft Studio by 5 p.m. on March 5.

Timeline

February 18 All submissions must be received by 5 p.m.

February 20 - 21 Juror selects artwork.

February 22 - 23 Notification sent to all artists who submitted artwork.

Craft Studio begins receiving accepted artwork.

March 8 Show opens.

March 11 Reception open to public from 4 - 6 p.m.

April 2 Show closes.

Artwork may be picked up anytime before 5 p.m.
